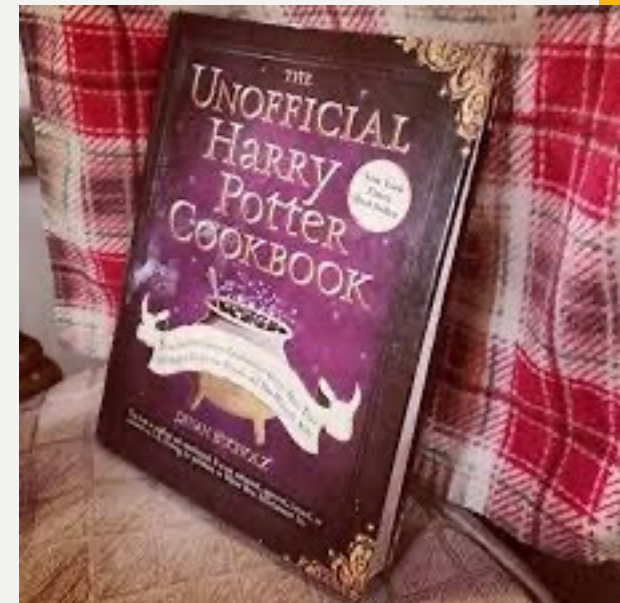

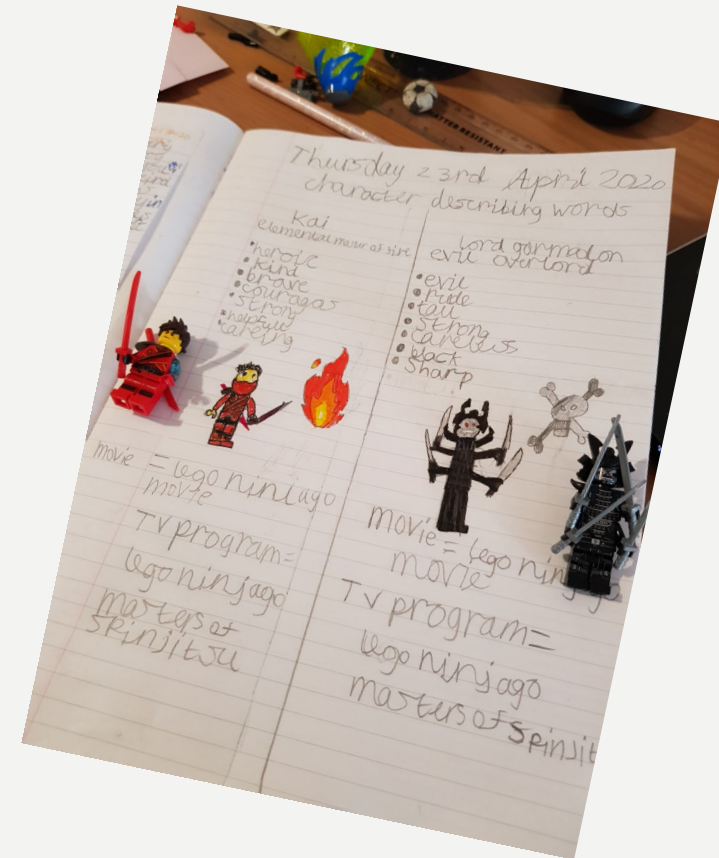
- Mikaal for continuing to be creative with his learning and activities such as planting, cooking and building a tent.

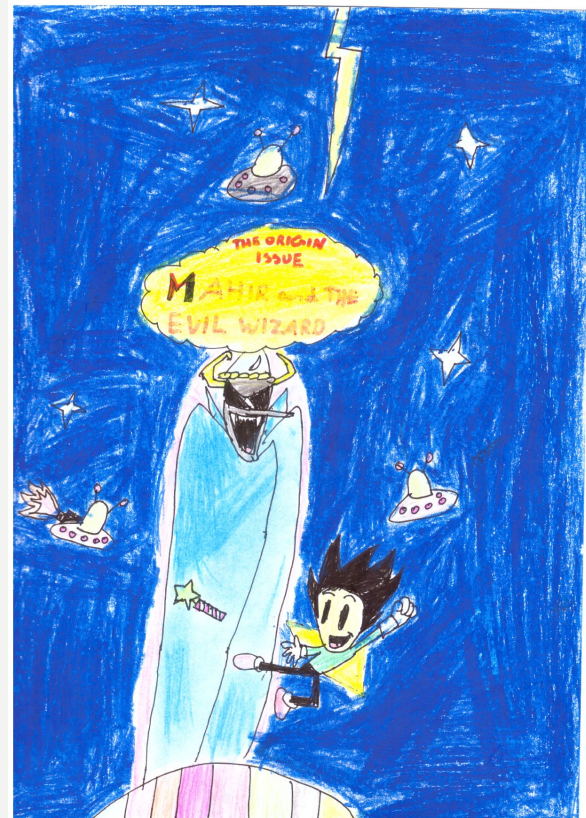
SUM DOG CHALLENGE IN YEAR 5
