1. Intensive Phonics, English and Maths interventions for pupils in all year groups with experienced teachers and specialist staff (SL, RS, YP, AM,SK,LM,JO)	£87,519	A strategy to ensure long-term development of core skills and accelerated progress.
2. Specialist support teachers for children with social, emotional and behavioural difficulties.	£5,403	To work in partnership with children and families to promote positive engagement in school and enable children to effectively access all learning opportunities by supporting their emotional wellbeing needs.
3. Structured Conversations Approach	£2,700	Cover for differentiated and structured conversations with parents of focus pupils.
4. Nurture Group support for KS1	£31,638	To raise achievement and improve well-being of pupils with emotional and social difficulties in Year 1 and 2.



5. Financial support for enrichment activities	£5,000	To enable vulnerable pupils to have access to a range of enrichment activities to support their learning, well-being and development.
